## Innehåll

### **8. Sammanfattning av projektet inkl. målsättning, planerade aktiviteter och förväntat resultat:**

**This pilot project will be lead by NordAN.**

This project is the basic pilot of a larger NordAN initiated project that aims to contribute to the implementation of national and regional drug policies – while providing an incentive to improve regional cooperation – by countering fragmentation and polarisation nationally and regionally, and to promote a balanced and comprehensive public health discourse on drugs.

The long term strategic task is therefore not only to promote a drug policy that is comprehensive and sustainable, but included in this task to conduct a structured dialogue with a broad range of actors in the drug policy field to make this happen.

The aim of this pilot project is to create a solid and broader NGO basis in all of the northern dimension partnership area by developing a specific NordAN Drug Policy Platform and by inviting a broader network of NGOs from all the countries in the region to join in a structured process towards increased corporation on how best to promote a balanced and comprehensive public health discourse on drugs.

In this application we suggest that this can be done in the form of joint memorandums of understanding, joint charters, resolutions and we also invite NGO partners to participate in the development of the NordAN initiated Drug Policy Dialogue Project

The aim of this pilot project is to allow for NGO participants to increase knowledge of the evidence base, share and discuss best practice, respect the beliefs, compassion and principles of others, invite to scrutiny and open minded self-assessment, and to identify and discuss the premises for a comprehensive and sustainable policy on drugs.

The structured dialogue process should take a basic public health comprehensive approach as point of departure agreeing on a modus operandi for the process such as dialogue, promotion of science, and aiming at consensus on a broad policy framework, and last but not least creating greater coherence and consensus in the drug policy area in particular between NGOs in the northern dimension area – thus improving regional corporation on the issues.

By expanding the NGO network co-operation both geographical and in numbers we aim at a yet deeper engagement among voluntary organisations in the entire northern dimension area on drug policy issues and hence increasing the interest in drug problems among groups who had not previously been engaged in the subject.

First of all we will continue the effort to support and strengthen the quality and competences of the existing NGO networks in all aspects of their role in society. Of course the active exchange of skills, experience and knowledge by the NGOs in the field of drug use and harm prevention, promoting of healthy lifestyle choices and care work for drug addicts and HIV/aids infected plays a role; but at the heart of the project we strive to discuss how the NGOs - working with prevention and care on a daily basis - could participate in the promoting of a balanced and comprehensive public health based policies on drugs.

The project activities hopefully bring about a continuous contact, interaction and corporation not only between NGOs but also between NGOs and governmental and intergovernmental officials and organisations, responsible authorities at all level of society in the region. By the project activities we aim to contribute to put the drug question higher on the political and public agenda. By countering fragmentation and polarisation in the debate between NGOs we aim to offer a joint NGO-civil-society-service by complementing the national and not less the regional policies by promoting a balanced comprehensive public health discourse on drugs.

- Translate scientific findings into a applicable measures and policies
- Discuss priorities, cost effectiveness and proportionality
- Function as a market place for the exchange of good practice.
- Address northern dimension region specific issues
- Make recommendations on priorities and actions.
- Develop a joint networkcreating synergi
- Increase understanding and cohesion at policy level between sectors, professions and interest groups;
- Strengthen the influence of the Northern Dimension region in the drug policies of the EU and UN.

## Nordisk nytta m.m.

14. Föreligger det en nordisk nytta med projektet, dvs. finns det mervärde och/eller synergieffekter genom att genomföra planerad aktivitet i nordisk regi jämfört med bilateralt eller nationellt?

Narkotikapolitikken i nordiske land er i utvikling.

Dette prosjekt – der indrager erfaringer fra de baltiske lande og vestrusland - vil kunne bidra til å påvirke ikke bare Ngoerne i de nordiske landene; men dermed også de nordiske befolkninger, regeringer disses posisjoner internasjonalt:

Skadereduksjon står stadig sterkere og trekker til seg resurser og oppmerksomhet i narkotikapolitikken på en måte som svekker eller truer med å svekke den helhetlige folkehelsebaserte politikken. Polariseringen og fragmentering gjør også nytenkning og mobilisering vanskeligere. Det er for eksempel vanskelig å føre diskusjoner om hvordan kontrollpolitikken og primærforebyggingen kan bli bedre fordi debattene om skadereduksjon dominerer. Et eksempel har heroin understøttet behandling, sundheds- og fixerum og prøytebytte tiltag en uforholdsmessig alt for stor del av den mediemæssige og dermed den politiske agenda.

Narkotikadebatten preget derfor av et bilde av at skadereduksjon og "tradisjonell politikk" som to motsetninger som ikke kan forenes. Dette tildekker for det første behovet for en saklig og evidensbasert diskusjon om tiltak både innen rammen av den tradisjonelle politikken og innen skadereduksjon.

For det andre hindrer det innovasjon, mobilisering og samarbeid.

Løsningen på begge problemer er at en får en diskusjon og prosess som ikke ekskluderer skadereduksjon som fenomen, men som søker å få til en prosess der en kan inviterer til kritisk tenkning.

Hovedmålsetningen å styrke premissene for en *effektiv* og *samlende* narkotikapolitikk. Med *effektiv* mener vi en politikk som reduserer skader og problemer knyttet til produksjon, omsetning og bruk av narkotika.

Med *samlende* mener vi en politikk som søker bred oppslutning, som er integrert, multi-sektoriell og som legger vekt på en helhetlig tilnærming.

En slik forståelse skal motvirke kortsiktighet, fragmentering og polarisering i narkotikapolitikken.

En slik forståelse har som mål å motvirke legalisering af narkotika.

15. Är projektet relaterat till liknande aktiviteter i regionala och internationella fora och i så fall hur?

The drug situation is often perceived as hopeless. Conflicts and discord are common. One reason for this – as well as the result of this - may be the lack of a common understanding and approach. This situation is reflected both at governmental, academic and volunteer (NGO) level as well as in the media.

At the centre of many of the discussions is the tension between preventing drug use by reducing supply, demand and offering treatment on the one hand and reducing harm done when drugs *are* used on the other. This is in our assessment a largely constructed and unhelpful dichotomy.

This notion of conflict and discord is in itself perhaps the greatest obstacle for advances in today's drug policy nationally, regionally and internationally.

Our view is that there is potential for greater cohesion in the drug debate, and that much of the differences may be resolved by involving others in a structured dialogue.

This, we argue may not only contribute significantly to regional collaboration in the area but also stimulate better policies elsewhere.

The project strives to Strengthen the influence of the Northern Dimension Region in the drug policies of the EU and UN. The project might even influence the way that the involved countries operate internationally. The Nordic and Baltic countries are a channel / bridge to the European Union.

Några av våra medlemsorganisationer driver jämställdhetsfrågan speciellt vilket på ett positivt medverkat till att den också står högt på vår gemensamma agenda. NordAN har oprettet en særlig kvindesektion, der har til formål at sikre at kønsperpektivet i alkohol- og narkotikapolitikken fremmes.

Konkret i projektet kommer narkotikaproblematiken också att belysas ur ett genusperspektiv.
